The Kristin S Conrad Lace Center Foundation has leased the ground floor suite of the Historic Mason Temple Building at 133 Fayetteville Street, downtown Raleigh, NC. The 4,500-square-foot facility will house the Raleigh Lace Museum, the first on the East Coast dedicated to the centuries-old art of lacemaking.

The Foundation has relied on donations from art patrons and friends over the past two years to fulfill its mission of providing a permanent museum space and a center for instruction, lectures, and weekly demonstrations. The center contains and extensive library and lace masterpieces spanning over 400 years.

Eying a June opening, current remodeling, curatorial work and interior design are underway, making the museum also an artful place for receptions, semi-formals, reunions, workshops and much more.
